The Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Limited, a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) constituted under the Companies Act for the implementation of Smart City Mission in Thiruvananthapuram, invites application from qualified and competent candidates for appointment to the following posts, on contract basis for a period of 3years for the upcoming new project on CITIIS 2.0. Interested candidates may apply via ONLINE mode only by filling the prescribed application form given in the career section in the website of Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Limited (www.smartcityvm.in).

Note: Candidates will have to upload their passport size photograph (taken within six months), signature and copies of certificates proving qualification and experience while submitting the application. Responsibilities

- i. Provide support to the department to implement the city's climate change work plan and Component 2 of CITIIS 2.0-related activities in consultation with the Director of the Urban Development Department.
- ii. Facilitate the preparation of necessary documentation and meetings for contractual processes and provide support to process Component 2 activities, and any other contract modalities follow up the activities and submit as per deadline and ensure all encumbrances get cleared on time.
- iii. Provide coordination and technical support in the development of policies, strategies, guidelines, and SOPs related to climate change, develop detailed programs and coordinate necessary arrangements for any technical missions/field visits related to the programme.
- iv. Ensure integration of data from the cities to the State Climate Data Portal and further to the National Data Observatory including data for all the indicators under the Climate Smart Cities Assessment framework (CSCAF).
- v. The State Climate Centre for Cities (S-C3) will provide essential technical support to develop the climate budget at the Urban Development Department (UDD) level.
- vi. Facilitate training and coordinate necessary arrangements to implement programme activities
- vii. Attend and participate in national/regional/global meetings/conferences and provide coordination and technical support to the country's delegation as and when needed.
- viii. Closely follow up with the Finance and Procurement team to review the proposals, detailed budget and follow-up of technical and financial reports according to the timeline.
- ix. Work closely with relevant state climate Change Cells/Centres, and departments/divisions to ensure good coordination and collaboration in the programme and work-related activities and encourage environmental sustainability.
- x. Bring innovative ideas and creative solutions to implement programme activities and be keen to learn and gain technical knowledge and skills in the field and for personal growth.
- xi. Conduct regular meetings, supportive supervision, monitoring and evaluation of programmes.
- xii. Prepare administrative/financial/technical reports related to Environmental and Climate Change as per guidelines and guidance from CITIIS-PMU.
- xiii. Provide other technical and administrative support to the Urban Development Department/CITIIS-PMU/City Climate Change Cell, as needed.

The selected candidate shall report directly to the Project Coordinator, under the overall guidance and supervision of the CEO, SCTL. Additionally, the selected candidate will be required to follow the instructions of and attend meetings organized by the CITIIS PMU (National Institute of Urban Affairs).The positions shall be hired for a minimum of 3 years.

General Instructions

1. The applicants are required to go through the detailed notification carefully and decide themselves about their eligibility for this opportunity before applying.
 2. SCTL will not be responsible for any discrepancy in the application submitted online.
 3. Applicants must compulsorily fill-up all relevant fields of applications and submit application through Online mode only.
 4. Incomplete/incorrect application form will be summarily rejected. Applicants should be careful in filling-up the application form at the time of Submission. If any lapse is detected during the scrutiny, the candidature will be rejected.
 5. The applicant should not furnish any false, tampered, fabricated information or suppress any material information while filling up the application form. If the particulars furnished in the online application form do not confirm with the original documents produced by the applicants his/her application will be rejected.
 6. SCTL reserves the right to cancel the notification or not fill the post advertised.
 7. Applicants should have a valid personal email ID and mobile no., which should be kept active till the completion of this appointment. All further intimations to the candidates will be through the registered email id and contact number only.
 8. It shall be noted that admittance to various stages of the recruitment will be provisional only, and will not confer any claim unless various other conditions of selection processes are satisfied. Detailed scrutiny of the applications/credentials will be conducted before interview/appointment. Any discrepancy found during the detailed scrutiny will result in the rejection of the candidature.
 9. SCTL reserves the right to shortlist only a limited number of candidates for test/group discussion/interview, as the case may be for the post, based on marks secured in their qualifying examination and experience. Candidate should clearly mention the marks scored in their qualifying examination in the application. The conversion of grade/CGPA to percentage would be based on the procedure certified by the University from where they have obtained the degree. The onus of proving the conversion from grade/CGPA to percentage of marks would rest with the candidate.
